Provider Checklist: (MUST BE REVIEWED EACH VISIT)

Contraindications: (Check all that apply)

- Otic Barotrauma (ear injury)
- Ear, sinus and/or throat congestion, head colds, virus, or prior trauma to ears
- Pulmonary hyper expansion (hyperexpanded lungs)
- Seizures
- Pneumothorax (commonly known as a collapsed lung)
- Compressive brain lesions, subdural hematoma, or intracranial hematoma
- If you are pregnant or planning to become pregnant
- Glaucoma
- Any implanted Medical Devices – Patient needs to see if its been tested
- Root Canal or dental procedure
- Implanted Devices (Pressure Tested?)

****IF ANY answer is yes please contact the office before your appointment to review**

Please come to the appointment with a clean face. No lotions or deodorant on face or body

We recommend avoiding anything causing gastric distress for 4 hours prior to treatment. This includes carbonated or caffeine

Have you had any changes to health or medications. This includes dental visits, pregnancy, procedures in the last 2 weeks.

Patients can have no petroleum products in the chamber (Vaseline, Aquaphor, Neosporin). Please review all lotions and creams with your provider.

Please refrain from: Body Lotions, nail polish (acrylic and dips must be 48 hours (about 2 days) old at the time of treatment), or hair products (i.e.: hair spray, gel, dry shampoo, or oil. ____

Smokers should refrain from smoking 2 hours prior to their treatment and 2 hours after. Smoking constricts blood vessels and interferes with the body's ability to carry oxygen. Smoking includes but is not limited to: Cigarettes, Vape, Gum, lozenges, Marijuana, Cigars. ____
